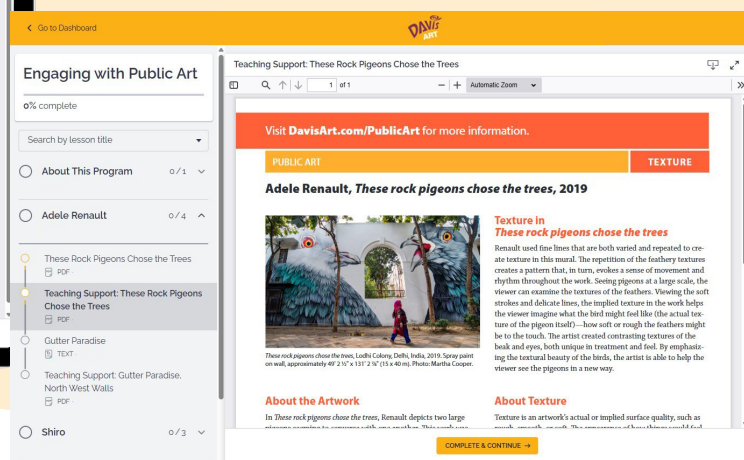
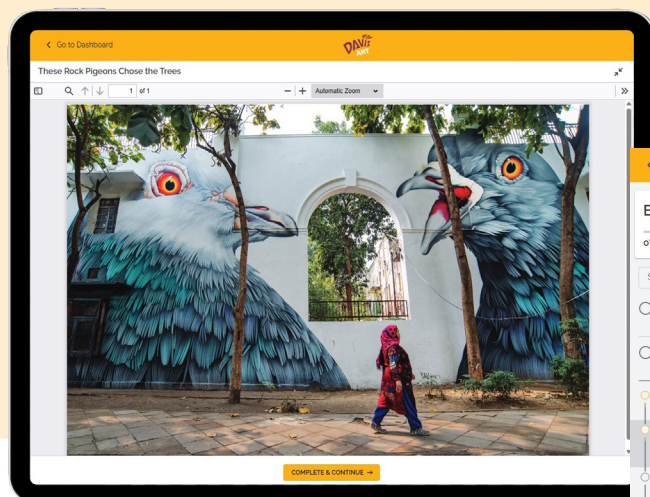




ENGAGING WITH PUBLIC ART
