

Professional Development with Tape Art®



OPTION 1: Full Day Face-to-face Session

Full day (up to 6 hours) session featuring tape artists and authors of *Collaborative Tape Art: The PiktoTape Method*, Michael Townsend and Leah Smith of the world-renowned Tape Art Crew. The artists will work with teachers in a hands-on experience to create larger than life, collaborative tape art installations in their school or community.

The time included in this session can be divided as needed to facilitate the number of teachers in a district. Please note that we suggest no more than 40 teachers per session with a suggested minimum session length of 2.5 hours.

OPTION 2: Online Site Facilitated Session for Teachers

Learn how to facilitate collaborative Tape Art® experiences from Michael Townsend and Leah Smith of the world-renowned Tape Art Crew. During this session, a small team of lead teachers are coached by the artists online via video conferencing (Zoom). This core team of teachers in turn facilitates the learning for larger groups of teachers on location. To complete the session, the full group of educators participate in a follow-up coaching session with artists.

Session Includes:

- Two books, *Collaborative Tape Art: The PiktoTape Method*
- Online (Zoom) sessions:
 - ½ hour Zoom session with artists and lead facilitators after materials are reviewed to plan and prepare
 - ½ hour Zoom session with whole group and artists to review presentations and provide feedback
 - 1-hour Zoom session with whole group that includes an artist talk and Q&A in real time
 - ½ hour follow-up session with on-site facilitators where artists will offer coaching as needed for successful replication in art rooms

OPTION 3: Online Site Facilitated Session with Students

Create meaningful art making opportunities for your students working collaboratively with professional artists. Facilitate an engaging experience they'll never forget with Michael Townsend and Leah Smith of the world-renowned Tape Art Crew. During this session students are led through the process of planning and creating a tape mural. The engaging experience concludes with a follow-up session with the artists to ensure students are comfortable creating tape art on their own.

- One book, *Collaborative Tape Art: The PiktoTape Method*
- Online (Zoom) sessions:
 - ½ hour Zoom session with artists and teacher after materials are reviewed to plan and prepare
 - ½ hour Zoom session with teacher, students, and artists to review presentations and provide feedback
 - 1-hour Zoom session that includes an artist talk and Q&A in real time with whole group
 - ½ hour follow-up session with students and teacher where artists will offer helpful tips for successful continuation of Tape Art® after their in-school experience.
